

12 Aspects of a Competitive Grant Proposal

A competitive grant proposal:

- 1. Meets the specific funder's eligibility requirements and funding priorities
- 2. Follows instructions
- 3. Does not contain errors
- 4. Is submitted on time through the correct channels
- 5. Tells a clear and consistent story
- 6. Includes financials that are clear, correct, and align with grant and budget narratives
- 7. Tells a compelling story
- 8. Uses qualitative and quantitative data to show actual need
- 9. Uses data to show evidence of success
- 10. Provides evidence of pre-existing collaborations, relationships, and partnerships
- 11. Clearly explains evaluation or assessment plans
- 12. Demonstrates financial support from other sources
